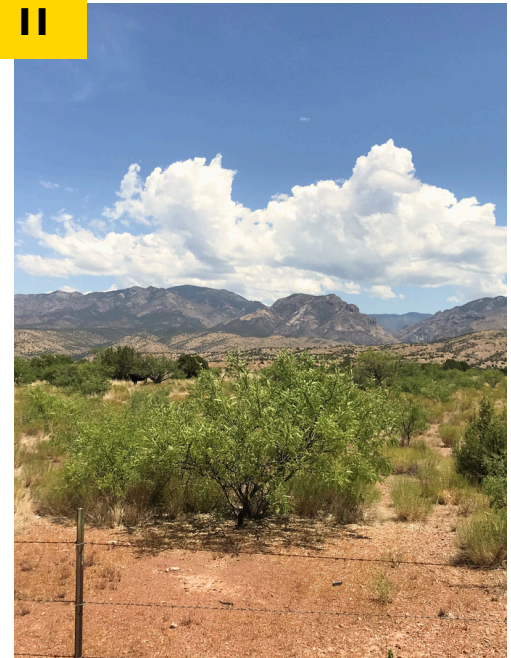
FIELD COURSE
